## Commuter rail could be put on hold

**TALLAHASSEE, Fla. (AP)** - A deal for the state to buy 61 miles of track from a private company for a commuter rail system in central Florida could be put on hold when the Senate takes up a transportation bill Thursday.

The bill's sponsor, Sen. Carey Baker, R-Eustis, announced at the end of Wednesday's session

that he would file an amendment deleting language about the commuter rail deal from the larger bill.

The deal has generated substantial debate in the House and Senate.
